1. About the project

We are both participants of the current ATO war in Ukraine and athletes supported by the the Kyiv city ATO veteran Union, are now organizing the "Chumaks' Way to America" bike ride, with the total length of 10 thousand km. The event is planned to take place within the period of May through September, 2018 over the following 19 states of the USA and Canada: California, Oregon, Washington, British Columbia, Alberta, Saskatchewan, Manitoba, Minnesota, Wisconsin, Illinois, Indiana, Ohio, Michigan, Ontario, Quebec, New York, New Jersey, Pennsylvania and Maryland.

Throughout our three months' route, we will pass hundreds of towns and cities, meeting dozens of hundreds thousands of Americans and Canadians, will hold meetings with local authorities in many places. Our audience, made up of over two millions cycling amateurs in Ukraine, USA and Canada, will watch info on our ride in social networks. We will written about, highlighted and shown on local mass media about 200 times.

Nel pomeriggio di mercoledì 3 agosto 2016 i ciclo-maratoneti ucraini raggiungono Verona, dopo aver viaggiato per 8.500 km attraverso l'Europa, con l'obiettivo di arrivare almeno a 10.000 prima di rientrare in patria. L'ultima tappa li ha visti pedalare per oltre 190 km (provenienti da Milano), prima di incontrare il nostro socio Oleksandr e gli amici di Fiab Verona.

Li aspetta un ricco programma di incontri ed esperienze. Oleksandr, con l'aiuto del console onorario dell'Ucraina Marco Toson e della sua assistente Andrea, hanno organizzato proprio cutto, fin nei minimi dettagli. Anzitutto una visita a un museo cittadino, approfitando dell'opportunità offerta a tutti i cittadini ucraini di entrare gratis nei musei veronesi, quale gesto di riconoscenza dopo il ritrovamento delle tele rubate a Castelvecchio. Terminato il momento culturale, la delegazione ha proseguito con una pedalata per le vie della città, in visita ai suoi mommenti principali, doviziosamente descritti dal nostro Paolo Weiss. Durante il tour hanno destato grande interesse gli incontri con le associazioni di volontaniato cittadine presso le quali Oleksandr presta servizio: oltre alla Fiab, tappa finale del percorso, anche la Croce Verde (di cui è stata visitata la sede storica di via Panvinio -ex "via Libera"-) e la Protezione Civile. Rappresentanti di ciascuna associazione hanno raccontato la loro esperienza, nella veste di ambasciatori di uno stile di servizio che i ciclonatti hanno promesso di voler portare in patria quale testimonianza significativa del "lifestyle" solidale veronese.

Una trentina di soci Fiab e cittadini si sono uniti al corteo festoso di biciclette, approfittando dell'occasione per condividere la visita ai monumenti e alle sedi delle associazioni, e conoscere una cultura che presenta molte insospettate somiglianze con la nostra. Il momento conclusivo, organizzato (con assaggi tipici) presso la sede Fiab di piazza Santo Spirito dalla comunità ucraina residente a Verona, ha rappresentato un momento di vero scambio e a micizia e ha consentito agli ospiti di poter raccontare il loro lungo viaggio e le motivazioni umanitarie che lo hanno ispirato.

4. Our advertising



- Our team includes veterans, possibly some disabled from the ATO war. Which will be a nice
 example of post-war rehabilitation. These people will always have more credit and respect among
 Ukrainian followers in social networks and mass media.
- We will be inviting American and Canadian bikers to join us for any distance. For this purpose, we
 have compiled a database of over 100 cycling communities on the route, with the total number of
 subscribers about 1,5 million people. We will be sharing interesting events, videos and pictures in
 these communities. That will help to spread positive information about Ukrainians to the
 American continent.

5. Cooperation with local media

How do we inform American and Canadian media of the ride:

- 1. We have our own database of 100 central and local American and Canadian media on the route, as well as about 300 Ukrainian medias, and we are continuing to expand it.
- 2. As our experience has shown, a large number of local media comes for the meeting as invited by the local Ukrainian communities.
- 3. We do hope to obtain mass media support from the USA Embassy in Ukraine and Ministry of Foreign Affairs in Ukraine, as well as the Ukrainian Embassies and Consulates in USA and Canada.
- 4. Back in Kyiv, we are leaving our headquarters, for active cooperation with Ukrainian and American media.

- The bike ride "The Chumaks' Way to America" is a true generator of positive news in an ocean of the negativism continuously poured out from TV screens and monitors onto an average Ukrainian. - The bike ride "The Chumaks' Way to America" is a charitable project. Funds raised during the trip will be given as an aid to those war-stricken in the Donbass area: families of the soldiers killed in battle, wounded soldiers, family based care homes that left the occupied area. - The bike ride "The Chumaks' Way to America" is also a sports project. We are riding our bikes over very long distances, 100-200 km daily, while in total you'll get an amazing number over 10 thousand kilometers. In any weather conditions, with any physical state and moods, overcoming weariness, pain, cold, heat, thirst, injuries, breakdowns and other externals we strive to arrive to the next destination point in time. Sport is a true symbol of peace and mutual understanding among nations.
